One of the important steps forward taken by Bilateral Investment Treaties (BITs) is the possibility to go to international arbitration. The ISDS mechanism has by and large been successful, both from an investor's perspective and a host State perspective. Despite this success, critical voices have been raised. Recently, alternative proposals have been by the EU Commission, among others. This is also being discussed in the recently commenced negotiations with respect to NAFTA. Professor KAj Hobér will explore and discuss the criticisms and proposed alternatives with a view to identifying future trends and developments concerning the settlement of investment disputes.
